




WINDOWS INTO HEAVEN SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Sheaf of Wheat


The primary Ingredient of the Eucharistic host which becomes the body of Christ.

Monstrance

Ave Maria


Hail Mary! wrapped In a rosary and scapular denoting Teresa's and Sheen's deep devotion to Our Lady.

St. Thérèse of Lisieux


Patroness of missionaries and Mother Teresa's namesake.

Modern-day, culturechanging saint who Is patroness of this student parish.


Sacristy Windows
